Official Guided/Unguided Tournament Rules

The following are the official Tournament Rules for the 2017 Salty Aggies Fishing Tournament. It is the contestants' responsibility to read, understand, and comply with all of the rules outlined below. Non-compliance will be grounds for disqualification from the tournament. By registering for and participating in the Salty Aggies Fishing Tournament, each participant agrees to be bound by Tournament Rules.

1. Anglers must be pre-registered to participate and no registration will be allowed on the day of the tournament. Entry forms must be received at stated address (5505 Fresno Dr, 78411) by stated entry deadline (July 25) to receive stated entry price. Entry forms received after the stated entry deadline will be required to pay an additional \$25 late entry fee by the end of the Friday night event (8/4/2017@10pm) in order to participate. Late registrants cannot be guaranteed a T-shirt. Tournament will be held rain or shine – no refunds.
2. This is an individual tournament. Up to four anglers can register on each registration form but are entered as individuals. Anglers may fish together if desired. Anglers may fish in any way they choose: boat, wade, surf, pier, jetty, etc. Fish must be caught on a rod and reel with live, dead, or artificial baits.
3. Tournament T-shirts will be distributed at the Friday Night Kickoff. Each entrant will be given one shirt in the size for which they registered. Shirts will also be distributed Saturday and must be picked up at the event and will not be mailed unless by written arrangement with the tournament directors.
4. Anglers must be present to be eligible for door prizes on Saturday.
5. This tournament focuses on fun and fundraising for the club. Professional anglers &/or full time fishing guides may enter the tournament or assist other anglers in the guided division only. Any individual(s) on a boat with a professional angler or guide shall be entered in the guided division. If it is determined that you have used a professional angler/guides services and are not entered in this division, you will be required to pay the additional fee or be disqualified.
6. Fishing is allowed only in Texas State waters.
7. Tournament fishing times are 6am to 2pm Saturday August 5, 2017. No captain's meeting or check-in required prior to fishing. The fish weigh-in location is downstairs at Doc's Seafood & Steaks under the JFK causeway on the Intracoastal Waterway. Weigh-in will open at noon and close at 2pm. Anglers must weigh in their fish between noon and 2pm or be in line with their fish at 2pm in order to qualify for tournament prizes or side pot prizes. The last person in the weigh in line at 2pm will be identified according to the tournament director's watch and no subsequent fish may be entered.
8. All state and federal laws must be observed. Fish must be of legal size according to Texas Parks & Wildlife Department regulations. Anglers may keep and enter only one trout over 25". No oversized/tagged redfish may be entered in the tournament. Each fish is eligible for both the tournament prize and one side pot prize if the angler is entered in both. One fish cannot be entered in multiple side pots.
9. The winning fish in 1st and 2nd place category will be the heaviest fish by weight in pounds as determined by the tournament weighmaster. The 3rd place category will be awarded to the fish closest in weight as follows: Redfish 4.5 pounds, trout 2.5 pounds. In the event of a tie by weight, the winner will be the fish with the longest overall length from head to pinched tail. In the event there is still a tie, the winner will be the fish that was weighed in first.

10. The three winning fish in each Unguided category (redfish/trout) will be awarded tournament prizes as follows (1st place \$225, 2nd place \$150, 3rd place \$100). The three winning fish in each Guided category (redfish/trout) will be awarded tournament prizes as follows (1st place \$275, 2nd place \$200, 3rd place \$150).
11. Guided and unguided participants will compete against each other in the side pots. The heaviest fish caught by an angler entered in the side pot will be awarded 50% of the side pot entry funds in that side pot. The second heaviest fish caught by an angler entered in the side pot will be awarded 25% of the side pot entry funds in that side pot. The heaviest stringer side pot will be awarded in the same manner.
12. The tournament weighmaster will be a professional fish handler hired to weigh in fish. If, in his/her opinion, any fish entered in the tournament was caught outside tournament fishing hours or was tampered with in order to alter weight or length, the angler entering the fish in question is subject to disqualification at the discretion of the tournament director. All decisions by the weighmaster and tournament director are final.
13. All protests, objections, or suspicions of violations of Tournament Rules must be provided to the tournament director in writing prior to announcement of the winners. Failure to provide timely written notification will be grounds for dismissal of the objection.

Official Lil Anglers Tournament Rules

1. The fishing tournament will run in 20 minute rotations from 9:30-11:30.
2. Lil Anglers must be registered and have a nametag before fishing.
3. All fishing will be catch and release. When a lil angler catches a fish, the volunteers accompany them to the tournament director to record size and species of fish.
4. The tournament weighmaster will be a professional fish handler hired to weigh in fish. All decisions by the weighmaster and tournament director are final.
5. While waiting for the next rotation to fish, families can mingle through the booths and participate in the activities provided in the family friendly area.
6. It is important to remember that this is a family event.
7. We will give prizes for most fish caught, largest fish, smallest fish etc. during the kids' weigh in at 11:30.
8. You must be present to win. The number of prizes will depend on donations received.
9. Lunch is served from 12:00-12:30.

The family friendly area is open from 9am – 2pm
